Scoring of Behavioural Dysfunction Questionnaire (BDQ)

All items are scored for their frequency or severity on a Likert-scale from 0 (none) to 5 (very often/very severe).

5 domain scores:

1.	Score "Disinhibition"	= Mean score of items 1.1 to 3.3
2.	Score "Apathy"	= Mean score of items 4.1 to 4.4
3.	Score "Loss of empathy"	= Mean score of items 5.1 to 7.3
4.	Score "Perseverative behaviour"	= Mean score of items 8.1 to 9.8
5.	Score "Hyperorality"	= Mean score of items 10.1 to 12
